## PRAYER NEEDS FOR OUR HOPE SCHOOL

Final exams for this school year are almost finished, then our HOPE children have maybe 7 weeks or so of summer holiday before the next academic year begins in June. Time is flying by! As you know, we're confident the Lord has led us to open up our little school to start taking in neighbor children also, with 2 basic goals in mind: 1: To minister the Lord Jesus to outside children, many of them from poor families or abusive homes, and 2: We've had a desire to try and find ways to start bringing some income into the HOPE home or save money in various ways, not being completely dependent on foreign support. By charging reasonable fees (but affordable for poor families), Lord willing we can offset some of the costs of operating the school. At this time the HOPE School is completely supported by the funds the Lord's provided thru gracious donors. With the fees we hope to eventually be able to not only meet all the costs of running a school, but hopefully can increase the quality of the school. *Please pray with us!*

Some of the needs of our upcoming school: Biggest financial need is for a vehicle to transport children to/fro the school. This vehicle can also be used for various other HOPE needs, including our weekly village ministry. Other needs are books, supplies & uniforms for our HOPE children, extra supplies for outside children when their parents aren't supplying properly, advertising the school, blackboards, an office desk for our principal (Isaac), extra chairs for teachers, extra teachers' salaries & salary for a watchman (can't take any chances with other people's children getting stolen!). Another need is playground equipment. Yea, it's a big endeavor, but we serve a BIG GOD! *"Is there anything too hard for the Lord?" **Sravanthi (12-4-95):** The photo at left is the only one we have before she came to HOPE. Sravanthi's father died of TB, mother died of AIDS. She was the first child in HOPE, coming in 1998. She's a precious girl with a gift of sharing stories. Going into 12th grade soon.



**Sadha (6-24-01):** Sadha's mother was sent out after caught in adultery. Father kept child with his mother while working; grandmother beating Sadha because she resembled her mother (real thinking person, huh). Father decided to put Sadha in a better home. Came in 2005.

**TUITION CENTER IN ORISSA:** At left is 27 or 28 beautiful children on their first day of school at the new tuition center started in a remote forest area of Orissa, India. These tribal people speak a language different than the state language of Oriya, so because of that and the fact the area is remote, there are no local schools for their villages. A school has been sanctioned by the govt. to be built, but the locals don't think that teachers can be found. Another problem is that when Christians in this region were persecuted in 2008, some children in hostels were killed when the hostels (schools) were damaged or destroyed. So the tribal parents aren't willing to send their children to hostels where the children would live away from the village. Thanks so much to you who have prayed or given so the Lord's mercies can be seen for these people!!! *"For the needy will not always be forgotten, nor the hope of the afflicted perish forever." ## HOPE CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

As most of you know, we've never been interested in merely doing social work, helping only with physical needs. Important as that is, a vital part of the HOPE orphanage ministry is to try and guide them into a life of service to our Lord Jesus, regardless of what the future holds for them: fulltime ministry, housewife, vocation, whatever. Besides the daily devotions in the home for the children & widows, our HOPE children have other ministry opportunities to people outside the home, one a monthly children's meeting and the other is weekly village ministry.

Once a month (2nd Saturday of each month for those of you who would like to pray) we have a children's meeting, inviting all the neighborhood children 12 and under to come to the HOPE home. Our older children make up most of the program schedule, which generally goes like this. Most of the neighbor children are usually late, so we have an hour or so of singing & action songs, both our HOPE children and neighbor children singing. During the meeting our HOPE children usually share the Word of God and at least one testimony, and sometimes there's a skit. Somewhere in there we'll break up the children into groups (like in the photo above), and our HOPE children will lead them in a Bible study, ask questions and have a time of prayer. Toward the end a HOPE adult will also share the Word. From 60 to over 100 neighborhood children have been coming. **Please pray** their young hearts will be deeply impacted in a lasting way!

If you're always standing and looking at the plant or flower that you've planted, you may not see or recognize the growth that's taking place, yet it's happening! In the same way, for those involved in the daily routine of a children's home—with schooling, duties, eating meals, bathing, bringing instruction & correction, etc.—we may not always recognize the work of the Spirit that is taking place in the children. In these children's meetings we can see how they are growing & maturing in spiritual things. They are joyfully & willingly leading their Bible study groups. Lord willing, in next month's nl we'll share about the village ministry.
