## HOPE SCHOOL NEEDS & PROGRESS

This will be the last newsletter that you'll receive before our next academic year begins at the HOPE School. We have many financial needs in order to get our school going properly. I read about the faith of George Mueller and Amy Carmichael, whom the Lord used to care for multitudes of children. Supposedly they never asked for funds, but only prayed and the Lord did wonders. These examples inspire our hearts, so there's this struggle between "trusting God", looking only to Him to do miracles (just giving the info about the ministry but not asking for funds, which both Mueller and Carmichael did); and "trusting God" while using the technology of Facebook, newsletters, e-mails, etc. to make appeals and raise funds. I DON'T LIKE asking for funds, but also realize that it's not about me or RHM, but it's about HIS work, HIS love and desire to reach out and impact the world with the knowledge of Jesus Christ.

So here we go again: Our HOPE School begins on June 13, so we have only a few weeks to purchase books, uniforms, all other needed supplies, and a vehicle to transport the outside children to/fro the school. For those of you who may be new to all of this, we at HOPE believe the Lord has moved on our hearts to expand our school for the upcoming year. For the last 5 years we have only been providing school for our HOPE orphanage children. After the 10th grade they must go to other schools to further their education. Our reason for expanding the school is 3-fold: 1. to meet govt. re-

quirements for private schools; 2. to reach out to more children with the love of Christ via the school; 3. to help offset the costs of the school (which is mostly teachers' salaries) by charging fees to the outside students. With the Lord's help we hope to implement other things to save and earn money for the home in future years, becoming less dependent on foreign support, especially if an economic disaster were to hit.

## PROFILES OF THE HOPE NEST

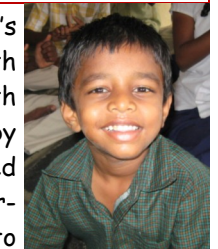


**Aswini (4-8-95):** Mother was raped, so father left the family; mother then committed suicide. Father later also died. Grandparents very poor and weren't able to care for Aswini.

She came to HOPE in 2002 at 7 yrs old. From Hindu background; now loves JESUS.



**Yesubabu (11-4-05):** Boy's mother is deaf & mute with mental problems. Living with parents, she was raped by unknown man and conceived Yesubabu. Later both parents died and she began to beg. Uncle brought him to HOPE. Birthday unknown, so we gave the day he come in '08.



Here is a list of some of our needs: Our most pressing need is for a van or small bus to transport children to/fro the school. For a good van large enough to transport possibly 100 or more children a day, we're looking at about \$12-14,000. Books (for HOPE children and outside children, which their relatives will then purchase from us): about \$1,000. Uniforms (same story as books): another \$1,000. Promoting the school thru ads, flyers, banners, etc.: \$250. Playground equipment (only 2 swings so far): whatever provision we get, we'll work with that for now. PRAY with us about all these things. "Now unto Him Who is able to do exceeding abundantly beyond all we can ask or think...to HIM be the glory" Ephesians 3:20-21

Compound wall only needs plastering & painting. School needs painting and various other works before being completed. Also need work done in playground area.

### FRUITFUL MINISTRY IN THE VILLAGES

In early May there was opportunity to visit one of the Gospel Band areas of ministry. Brother Samuel and his son Puthra have been doing ministry in the village of Voletivaripalem for many years, also reaching out and establishing churches (not buildings, but believers) in 3 or 4 other villages as well. Friends, this ministry is a lot of what Right Hand Ministries is about: these men and their families have no home of their own (living inside their church), yet they have faithfully ministered in these poor villages for years. We have asked the Father to connect us with poor ministers and ministries that have little or no contact with foreign sources, who we can help to fulfill the vision and calling of God upon their lives. Thank You Lord for giving us this opportunity to help equip Your poor saints!

There are several cultural issues that make village ministry a great challenge: because most work in the fields, need to finish their cooking (they eat late) and do other duties beforehand, meetings may not start until after 9pm. A person's caste may also hinder them from coming to a meeting if lower caste people are there. Perhaps every time we've tried to have a meeting in the village of Chundi, there are power cuts. But the Lord has strengthened these brothers to do the ministry, and we admire them. During 5 days we shared in at least 6 different villages & towns, and in many homes. We trust for lasting fruit. Some money has come for them a home; pray for its completion.

The mother brought her to HOPE for her protection. They don't know her birthday, so we chose her coming day (5-11). We're guessing 4 yrs, but maybe only 3. Real name is Thirupathamma (a goddess). Renamed her Thabitha from Acts 9:36.

Continue to pray for the believers in Orissa, who have not had any severe persecution since 2008, but it isn't easy to penetrate into the strongholds of satan. The Morning Star ministry we are connected with is doing well, and gradually more are coming to Christ. We're excited that the tuition center is doing well, which the Lord is using to raise the literacy rate among the forest tribal children there in Orissa. Pray that the Lord will enable us to do more for these precious village people.

**MANNA PROGRAM UPDATE:** Please pray for our widows at HOPE. Really, there are some needs that we are struggling to meet for lack of help and lack of time (the school and other ministry is swallowing our time). We have about 15 widows who need cataract surgeries (we only pay for glasses and prescriptions), 4 new huts to build and one roof repair to make.
