



# RIGHT HAND MINISTRIES

*“Then the King will say to those on His Right Hand, ‘Come, you who are blessed of My Father...for I was hungry and you gave Me food, thirsty and you gave Me drink, a stranger and you took Me in, naked and you clothed Me, sick and you visited Me, in prison and you came to Me.’”* *Matthew 25:34-36*

Right Hand Ministries is a non-profit organization established for the purpose of helping others to see and experience the heart of God. As we see in the above Scriptures, those who are blessed of the Father and who will be at the “right hand” of Jesus at the Judgment are those who are carrying out His desire toward the hurting and needy. One of RHM’s primary goals is simply to be a channel of the Lord’s support to whomever He would lead us to assist. As human beings, we often measure success based on the size of the ministry or the credentials of those involved. But “God has chosen the foolish things...the weak things” to often carry out His work. We rejoice that He has helped us to connect with those whom He has called and gifted, yet they are poor, perhaps uneducated and have no means of their own to do what He’s placed

within their hearts. This brochure is a brief summary of some of the ministries we are teamed up with, as well as sharing some of the burdens of His heart. Please read prayerfully, and ask Him if this ministry is something He would have you to be a part of. We want everyone who joins with us to feel that they are part of a team, working together with Christ carrying out His work: some inform, some give, some pray, some do the hands on ministry, etc., but only One gets the glory!

You’ll probably recognize that one of our primary goals is to work with Him in rescuing as many orphans, destitute children and widows as possible from their life of brokenness and rejection. But we’ve also been able to bring a blessing to others in various ways.

One ministry we’ve been connected with for many years is called Gospel Band, a “band” of many churches in small towns and villages in India. This

ministry has been in existence since the 1950’s, but most of their ministers are very poor. God’s enabled us to come alongside them with financial support, which has helped them over the years with repairing their small churches, cover medical needs, purchase a motorcycle for Gospel Band leaders to help them in traveling more efficiently to the villages, and assist their ministers during crisis times.

Murthy (above photo) is a pastor, also in India, who at 19 years old planned to throw himself into an abandoned well. He felt the need to confess his sins before committing suicide, and ended up repenting and committing his life to Jesus. He is a mentor for many other ministers, and uses the funds we send to help them when in need, and also for his own family and ministry needs.

The Lord’s used us to help rebuild 2 churches that were burned, assist a leper camp, a deaf congregation, a boys shelter and provide for many other physical, ministry and medical needs over the years. It has also been placed on our hearts to help young pastors with



physical or ministry needs as the Lord is helping them establish their ministries.

The little girl to the left, perhaps 4 at the time, was found on the beach eating sand. Turned out that the stepmother didn’t want her, scarcely fed her, and was beating and burning her. Our friends Smitha & Nora found her. Smitha’s mother, Mary Buelah, who later started the HOPE orphanage we are connected with, took Hannah from that abusive

situation and nursed her back to health. Folks, do we have any idea just how many children there are in the world who are unwanted, orphaned, abandoned, abused, molested? There may not be any truly reliable estimates, but we know they number in the millions!! An orphanage that RHM is heavily involved with is called HOPE, also in India. Of the children at HOPE, almost 75% had one or both parents die or abandon them. Of the rest, 75% were abused. Only one child has come to the home due strictly to extreme poverty, and ALL the children needed Jesus to heal their hearts. *"A Father of the fatherless and a Judge for the widow is God is His holy habitation. God makes a home for the lonely"* (Ps. 68:5-6).

rescue and support of multitudes of broken and abused children, whether they be orphans, abandoned, affected by AIDS, caught in the horrid racket of child sex trafficking, street children as a result of war, etc..

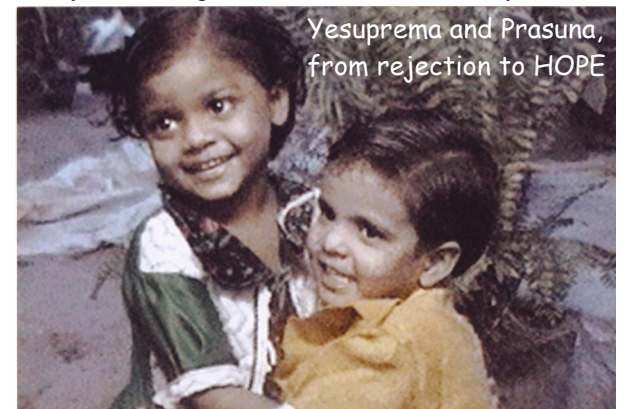
One thing we've found is that an orphanage is an ideal place to also care for needy widows; rejected and impoverished widows finding love and provision, and children learning to serve others. *"Pure and undefiled religion in the sight of our God and Father"* finding it's fulfillment in one home and ministry (James 1:27). The HOPE family/orphanage has began a widow feeding ministry called the HOPE Manna Program. The majority of widows (and some widowers, almost all of them professing Christians) have children and grandchildren, but they either don't want them or are too poor to care for them. A smaller percentage of the widows are totally alone and have no one to care for them. Thus far, we've had a part in feeding widows

twice a day, giving them a new dress each year, making sure they have sweaters, blankets and scarves for the cold weather, and being able to repair some of their thatched roofs. We're trusting in His wisdom and provision in regard to caring for the more desperate widows who are homeless or reach a point when they need someone to care for them, but have no one to do that work. Again, please pray for us, as these are among the most forgotten, neglected and rejected people in the world, but the Father has not forgotten! *"For the needy will not always be forgotten, nor the hope of the afflicted perish forever."* Psalms 9:18
